

Week 3 - Copy Cat

Equipment: Basketball and Basketball Hoop

Instructions:

1. Decide Who Goes First: Play rock-paper-scissors to determine who starts the game.

2. Taking Shots:

- The first player takes a shot from anywhere on the court. Get creative with your shots! You can add spins, shoot with your non-dominant hand, or even attempt a layup.
- If the first player successfully makes the shot, the second player must replicate the same shot. If they miss, the second player gets a chance to shoot from anywhere they choose.

3. Scoring:

- If the first player successfully makes the shot and the second player misses, the second player doesn't earn a letter.
- If the second player makes the same shot, they earn a letter. If the second player misses, move on to the next round.

4. Spell "CAT":

- Keep taking turns until a player spells out the word "CAT."
- Competitive: For each letter spelled, 1 point will be awarded to each participant. For a greater challenge and more points, try spelling more 3-letter animal names!

Additional Tips:

- Ensure that the shots chosen by the first player are reasonable and not overly difficult for the second player to replicate.
- Encourage creativity in shot selection and technique to make the game more exciting.
- Consider offering variations or adaptations of the game to accommodate different skill levels or preferences.
