



Greg Ryan

Born and raised in Calgary, Greg has been part of the Volleyball landscape in Alberta and Canada for almost thirty years. Greg received his Bachelor's of Education degree and Master of Kinesiology (Art and Science of Coaching) from the University of Calgary. He is a Chartered Professional Coach in Canada and is a Level 4 NCCP coach.

As a player in High School in Calgary he played on two City Championship Teams. As a player at the University of Calgary he was a Canada West All-Star and CIAU Tournament All-Star on a rookie-laden team that won the Canada West Conference and placed second at the CIAU championships. He coached for more than twenty years at the University of Calgary. In that time his teams competed in the CIS Championship 13 times, winning twice and medaling six times. His teams medaled 13 times in the Canada West Conference. In addition to this Greg has been active coaching at the club level in both men's and women's competition. His club teams won three National Championships. More than ten of his athletes have played professionally in Europe and the Orient; two of these have gone on to be Olympians. Greg was Coach of the Year five times in the Canada West Conference and Volleyball Canada Coach of the year one time.

Greg has also coached internationally. While at U of C and Montana State he took his varsity team to Europe and toured through both Eastern and Western Europe. He also coached with Canada's National team in various capacities for the last twenty years. He coached at the World University Games four times. His best finish was in 2003 as the Head Coach in the Daegu South Korea Games, where the team finished 7th. In 2001, Greg was selected as Honoured Athletic Leader by the Calgary Booster Club. In 2014, he was inducted as a Coach into the Alberta Volleyball Hall of Fame.

Greg and his wife Alyson (a Hay Lakes native), reside in Camrose with their children: Jessica, Joshua, Anna and Luke. His son, Luke, competes for Augustana in Volleyball.

We are honoured to welcome Mr. Ryan to our 1A Girls Provincial Championship and eagerly anticipate his words of wisdom!






