

Spectator Information

Admission Athletes and coaches will be issued ID accreditation to enter during competition. All spectators will need to purchase a pass to watch the competition.

Spectator Admission Rates & Programs:

Spectators will have the option to purchase a Day Pass or a Tournament Pass. The Day Pass will be valid at both venues only for the day of purchase. The Tournament Pass is valid at both venues for the entire weekend. Spectators must present their passes on entry to the venues.

Parking On Friday, parking will be limited as school is in session. Parking is available in the front or back parking lot, on the streets and residential areas surrounding the school. Fan Expectations

This is evidenced by the absence of booing and vulgarities. Spectators must also show proper acceptance of officials' judgment. Artificial noisemakers are not permitted during provincial championship tournaments/events. These noisemakers may include but are not limited to: air horns, cow bells, plastic tube horns, garbage can lids, etc. The provincial championship host shall have the authority to eject from the competition facility individuals who, following a warning, refuse to comply with this requirement.

Fan's Yellow Card

This yellow card is being given to you as a warning that your behavior may not be appropriate for this educational setting. Realize that your attendance is a privilege to attend and watch a match and support high school athletics, not a license to verbally assault players, coaches or officials. High school student athletes helped write the following message for you: "It's not your game, it's ours, the athletes that are competing. We hope the spectators will watch, enjoy, encourage and be proud of us, win or lose. We need your support and enthusiasm, not your yelling and criticism."
